The Clinical Aphasiology Conference is an annual conference devoted to clinical issues relevant to diagnosis, evaluation, and treatment of brain-injured persons with impaired communicative abilities. Attendance at the conference is by invitation. Invitations are based upon summaries of presentations submitted by potential participants for consideration by a program committee. Summaries are read without knowledge of authorship by four persons who constitute the program committee. Committee members rank-order and rate proposed presentations in terms of scientific and clinical merit, relevance, and their potential for generating useful discussion. Papers presented at the conference are eligible for inclusion in that year's volume of Clinical Aphasiology.
